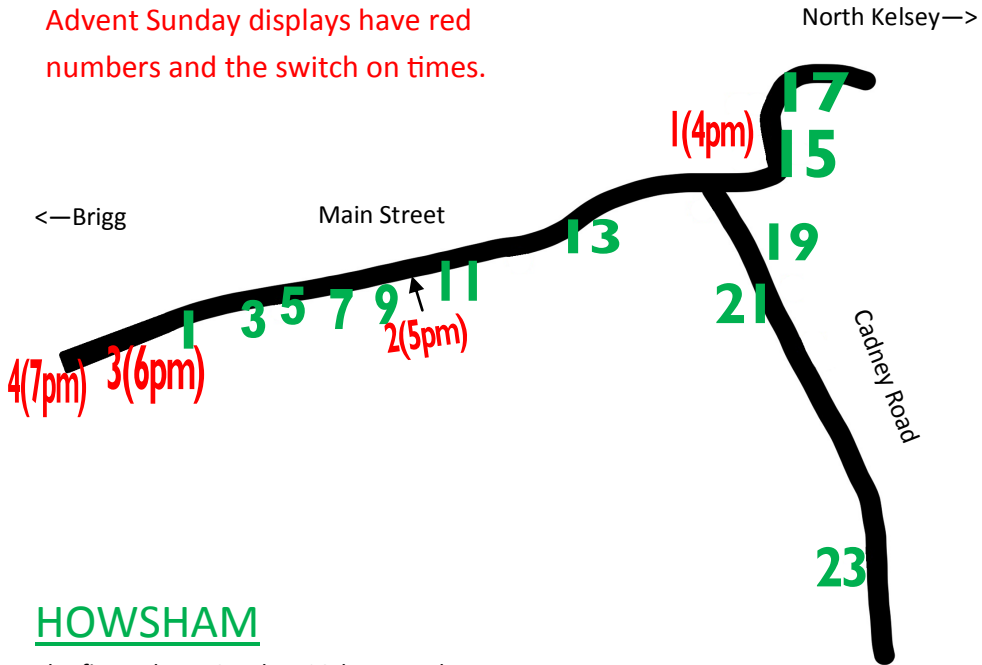

Advent Sunday displays have red numbers and the switch on times.



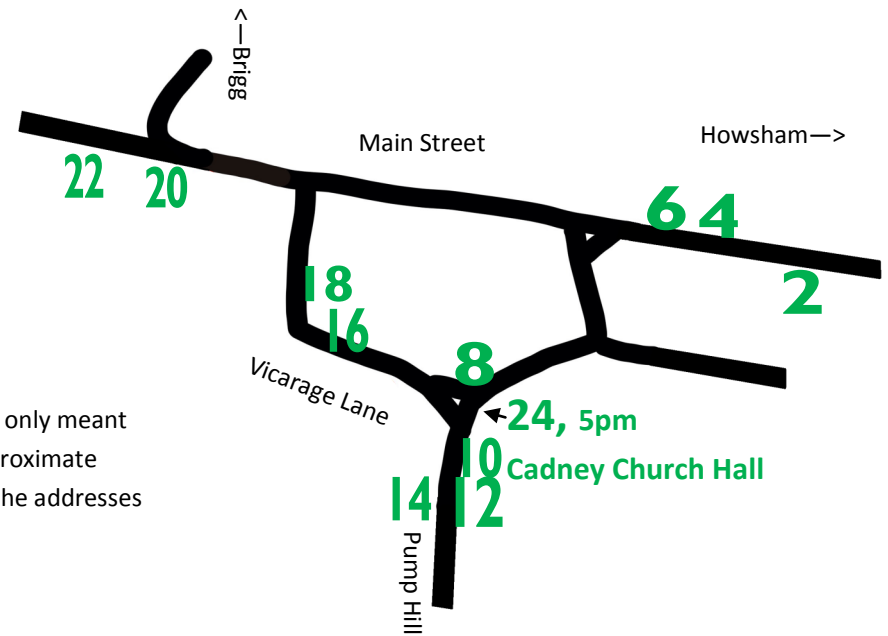
