The Parish council met on 13th September when one application for the two councillor vacancies, Susan Margaret Hoy was duly coopted and after signing the Declaration of Acceptance joined the meeting with the three councillors present.

Parish issues discussed included:

War memorial—Cllr Hempstock reported on research of an engraved 3 seater resin bench and agreed to further enquire of the costs complete with delivery and fixing requirements.

Village Pond—Resolved to seek quotations from the 3 contractors listed in the report as circulated 05/09 for the works as per the Survey Report. Program section 8.

Village Trees—Resolved not to proceed with this item.

BT Call Box—The information Pack was circulated to councillors on 12th July following the July meeting to enable councillors to carry out an inspection and report at the meeting was deferred to the November meeting.

The Clerk was requested to take up the following items with the appropriate authority:-

Due to recent flooding to request the drains on Cadney Road Howsham to be jetted and surveyed for adequate drainage by NLC Highways.

Request a Speed Survey to be carried out on Main Street, Cadney.

LCC & NLC to survey the C259 Cadney Road to Brigg road surface due to subsidence—cc Ward Cllrs & MP.

Request NLC to provide a suitable footpath to be provided on the East side of Main Street to align with the end of the footpath on the west side to provide safe access to the Bridle way.

The next meeting will be held on Wednesday 8th November 2017 at 7pm in the Parish Room, Cadney when the topics will be discussed along with the 2017/18 budget.
