Call box, 01652 678301
Main Street, Howsham

A notice dated 04/10/16, which was placed in the above call box, has only just come to the notice of the Parish Council and following the instructions on the notice to contact the Local Planning authority, in this case North Lincolnshire Council, I am informed that they have no knowledge and do not appear to have been notified as per BT requirements. *As well as letting the public know, BT must tell certain organisations about their plans to remove the call box.*

Last year BT liaised with West Lindsey DC to carry out a consultation with Parish Councils notifying of the current usage and proposed plans to remove. However, it would appear the same process has not been carried out in North Lincolnshire. - *It would be interesting to know why!*

Based on interest received I have provisionally registered an interest in 'adopting' the call box which can be formally ratified at the next PCM.

So ideas please on what purpose this could be utilised as a community asset!

Deb Hall brought the phone box and it's possible removal to the parish council's attention, after Deb and her husband happened to peer in the phone box while on a walk around the village. There was no notice on the outside, just a notice stuck up inside the box.

Phone boxes can be 'adopted' for just £1. If you look up 'new ideas for old phone boxes', there are many different ideas for new uses, but one of the most popular seems to be fitting shelving and creating a 'book swap' or mini library. Some have had the windows removed and have plants growing out and climbing around the box. I read of one with an Ordnance survey map and local information inside, while others are used as art galleries. Please also look up Mellis Phone box, villagers created their own stained glass pieces, then replaced all the old glass with stained instead. It looks wonderful. Howsham phone box has Perspex 'glass' panels and they are all scratched or have cigarette burns in them. What are your suggestions?
