<u>Best Kept Village</u>

Here are some of the comments:

Considerable effort has been made to enhance the environment with floral displays and effective planting. There is a good border of grasses and flowers on Main Street opposite Clayton's Corner. There are wooden planters with a good variety of plants at the village sign on the B1434 and on Cadney Road, where there are also two excellent raised beds opposite Chestnut View. The planting at the Village Hall is excellent and extensive.

The playground is a compact and attractive area behind the village hall with a good range of wooden equipment. The grass was reasonably wellcut and the wood chippings recently renewed. The planting around the playground makes it an attractive site. Particularly imaginative are the old tyres cut away and attached to the fence to create planters with a good range of flowers.

Residents are also to be commended for some attractive gardens e.g. on Williamson Close and Cadney Road, where a number of properties have colourful borders or planters outside.

The café occupies a prominent position on the main road through the village and has some excellent floral displays around the site.

We scored full marks for the Playground, scored 146/150 in the small village category and 48/50 in the community planting. Well done everyone.
