Would it be possible for the police to do random speed checks on Cadney Road in Howsham?

The Police can't use the traffic calming flashing lights on this road as there is a problem with sourcing power

It was suggested that Parish Councils collecting the information to pass onto highways teams to find speeding spots is of great importance and Claire highlighted the new enforcement system; Community speedwatch.
